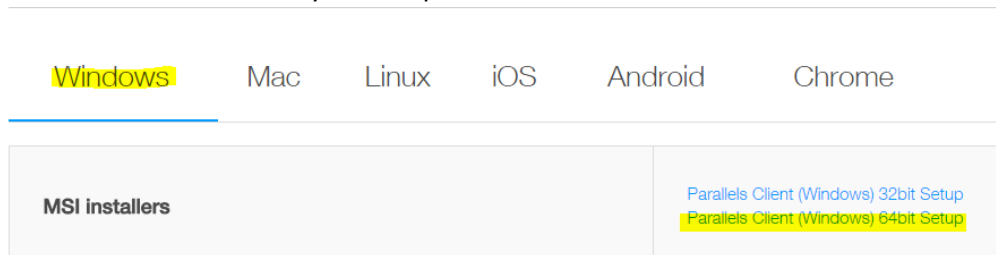


How to Install Parallels

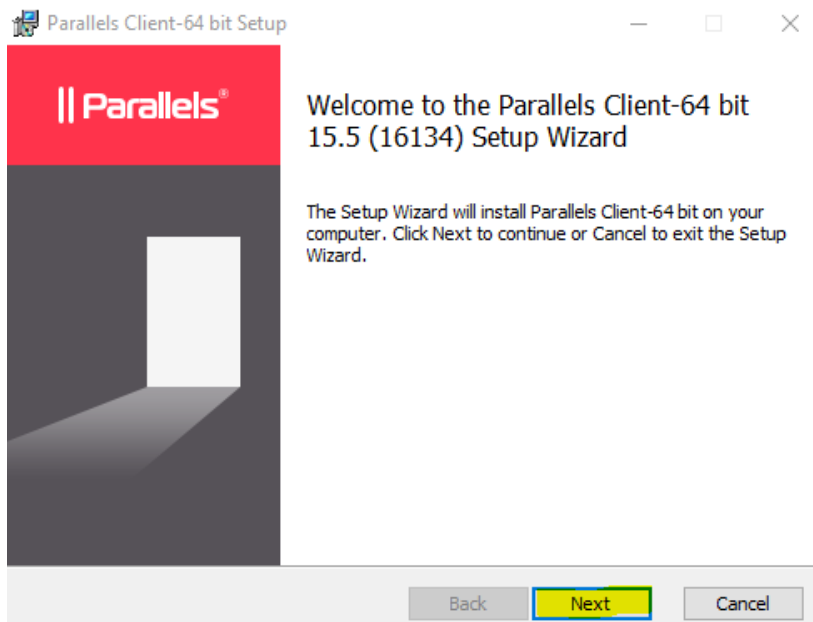
Instructions for Mac and Windows are below; please choose your operating system accordingly.

Windows

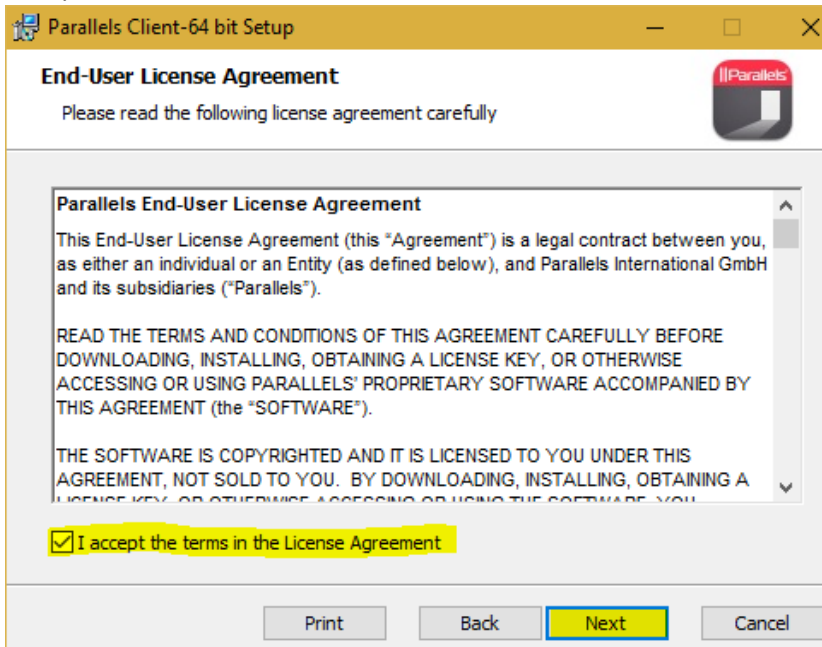
1. Navigate to <http://www.parallels.com/products/ras/download/client/> and download the Windows MSI Installer for your computer.



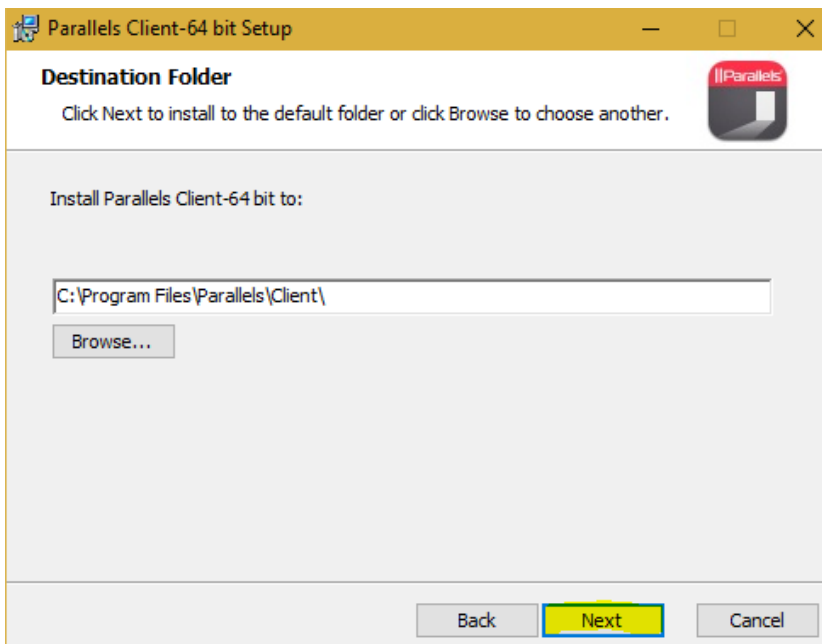
2. Double-click the installation file and click **Next** to begin installation.



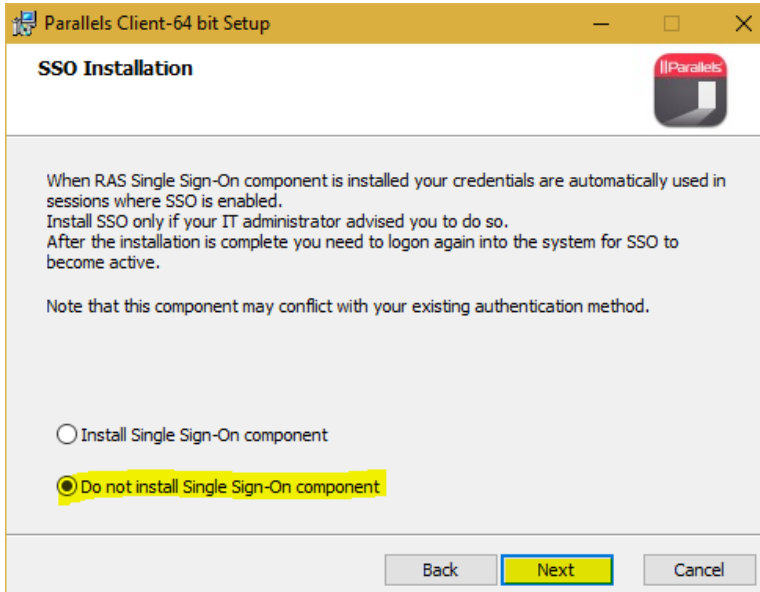
3. Accept the terms, then click **Next**.



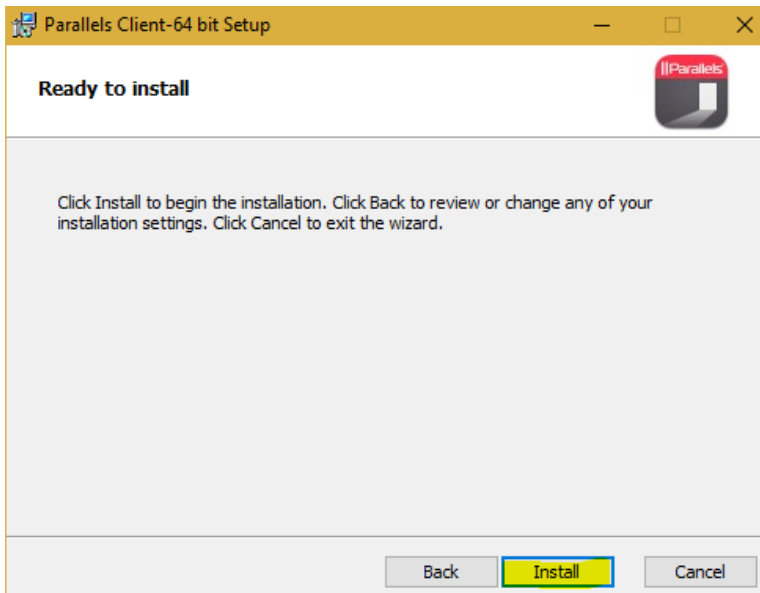
4. Click **Next**.



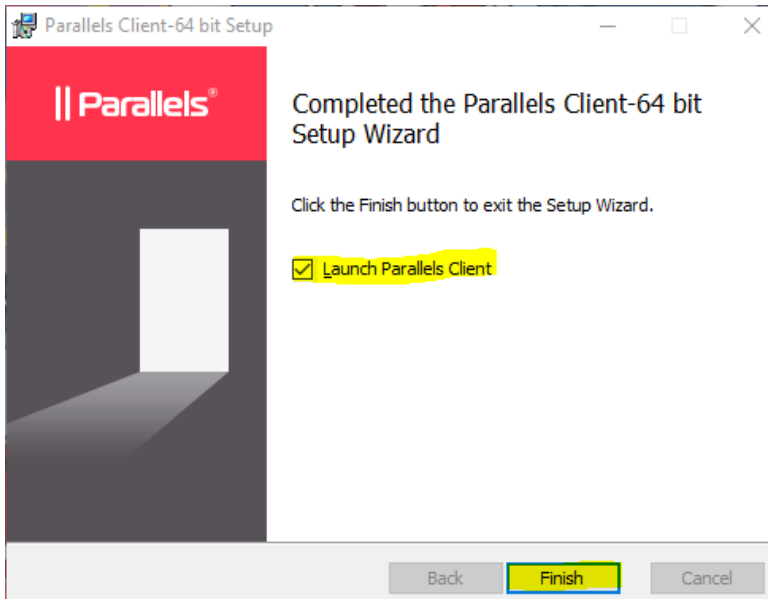
5. Make sure **Do not install Single Sign-On component** is selected, then click **Next**.



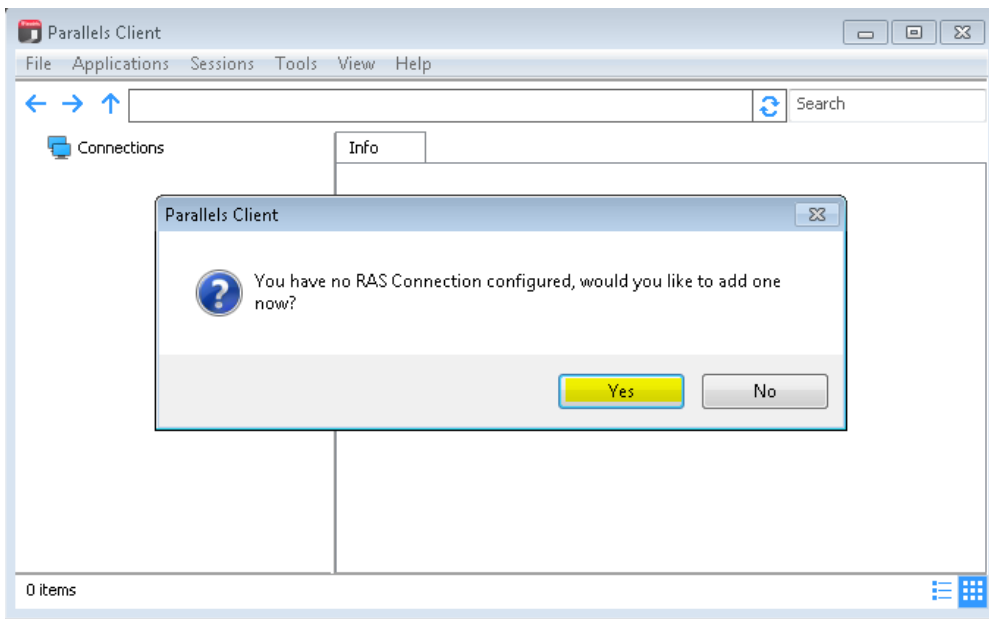
6. Click **Install**.




7. Check **Launch Parallels Client**, then click **Finish**.



8. Click **Yes** to create a connection.




9. Enter the following details:
 - a. **Server:** bammercury.ba.ttu.edu
 - b. **Connection mode:** Gateway SSL Mode
 - c. **Friendly name:** RCOBA

10. Enter your eRaider username and password. Click **Connect**.

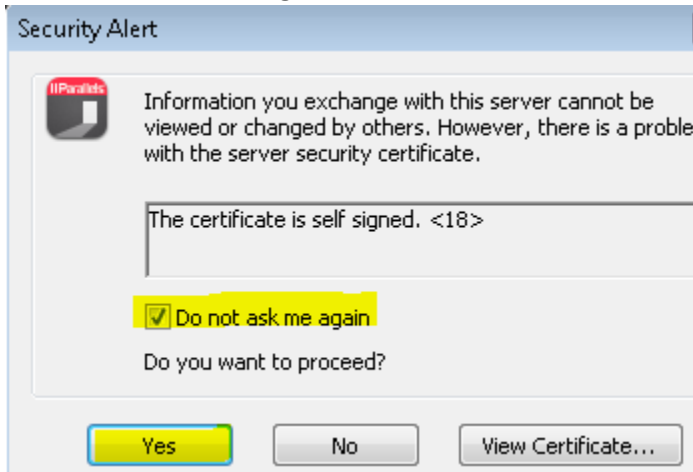

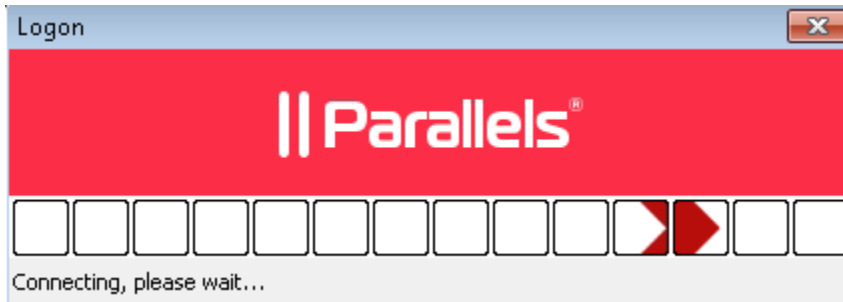
11. Double-click the SAS application you wish to launch.



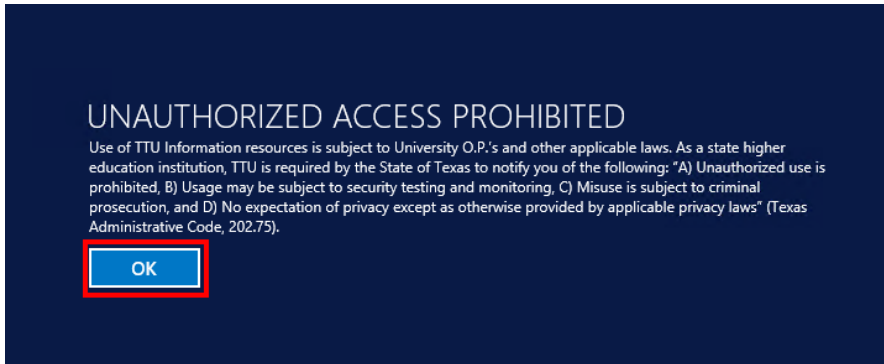
12. Check **Do not ask me again**, then click **Yes**.



13. Parallels will take a few moments to connect to the server.

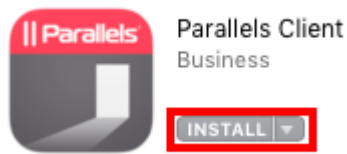


14. Click **OK** when you see the following window appear.



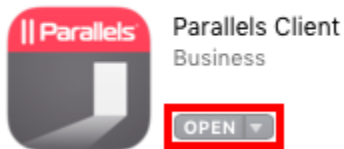
Mac OS X

1. On your Mac, open the **App Store** and search for “Parallels Client” and then install it.

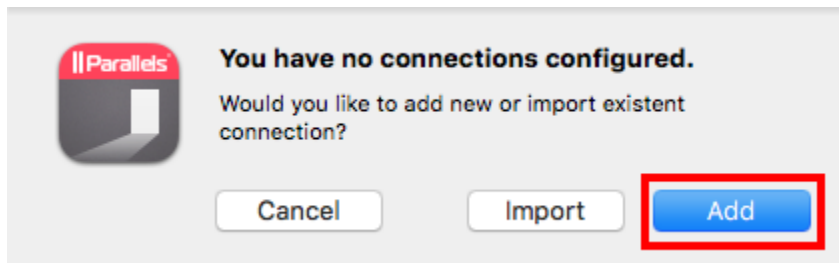


2. After installing the app, click **Open**.

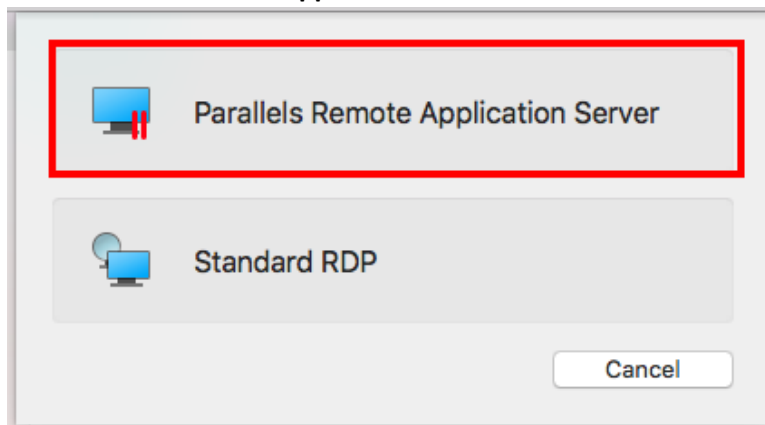


3. Click **Add**.

5. Enter the following details:
 - a. **Server:** bammercury.ba.ttu.edu
 - b. **Connection mode:** Gateway SSL Mode

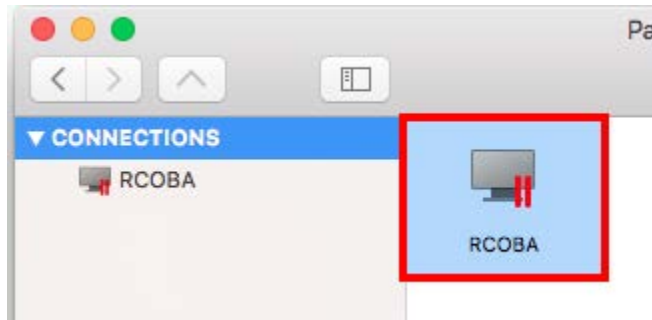



6. Double-click the RCOBA icon.



7. Enter your eRaider username and password, then click **Login**.

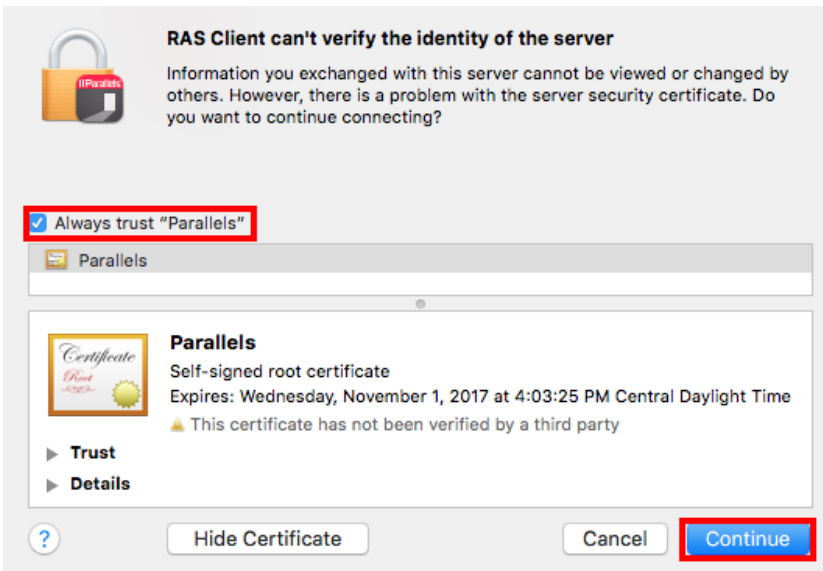
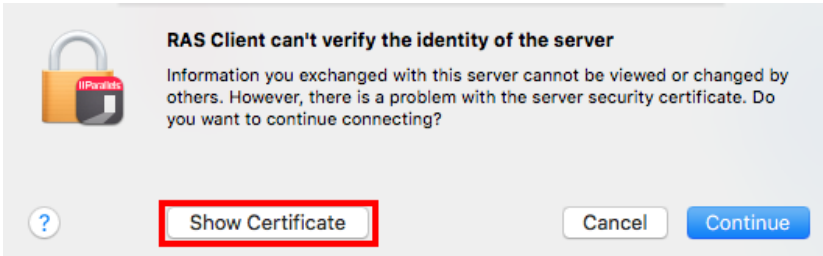

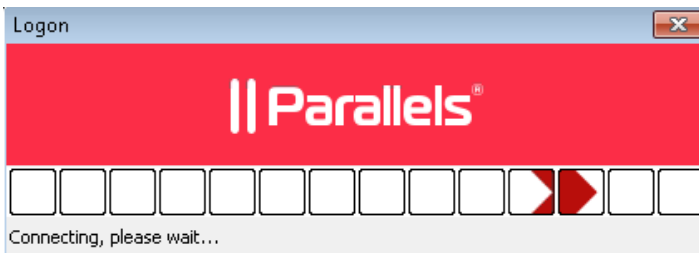
8. Double-click the SAS icon to launch the application.



9. If you receive the following box, click **Show Certificate**, then check the box **Always trust "Parallels"**. Click **Continue**.



10. Parallels will take a few moments to connect to the server.



11. Click **OK** when you see the following window appear.
